



**Radical RADD Racing (RRR)

2008**

Radical RADD Racing has held a non-profit status for one year, 2008. In that one year, we have accomplished much as a Board and as a non-profit corporation supporting youth team sports for the underprivileged youth and young adult.

2008 INTENTIONS

The goal of \$15,000 the first year was a big stretch. Initial plans focused on providing scholarship funds to riders for two key events, MN BMX event and Rockford IL BMX event, both in June.

2008 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Overview

We succeeded in raising \$1700. This allowed RRR to give scholarship funds to xx riders for the MN National event, purchase a bike repair stand, for the team bike repairs at events and practice, and buy team jerseys. RRR also restructured the team, going from 48 riders with a range of financial abilities to 20 underprivileged riders. This reorganization will allow RRR to be fully committed to its intentions of providing scholarships to youth and young adults to participate in the BMX sport and events.

Marketing, Communications and Awareness of RRR

- A brochure exists for use to attract contributors and sponsors.
- The website now provides both team and sponsor/contributor information so that it is consistent with other non-profit websites.
- RRR team riders and coach participate in local city parades. In 2008 they rode in three parades: Coon Rapids, Lino Lakes and Mounds View.

2009 PLANS

RRR plans to continue working with the team at its current size of 20 riders. Competition participation will focus on regional BMX events, namely Minnesota, Illinois, and South Dakota. Scholarships for entry fees are the major expenditure for the year with \$100 fees/rider/event. Our fund raising goal will be \$5,000, which is more realistic and still will be a stretch to achieve given the economic times. Fund raising will be a team effort through car wash events and other activities. Sponsors and contributors will also be approached to raise monies for the entry fees.
